PENDING DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN UPCOMING PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY

March 27 Deadline to Register; April 5 Deadline for Mail Ballots

WARWICK, R.I. – If you are a Rhode Island resident and want to take part in the upcoming April 26 Presidential Preference Primary, the Rhode Island Democratic Party reminds you of these two important dates: **March 27 to register to vote in the Primary, and April 5 is the deadline to apply for a mail ballot.**

To register, you may do so at your local board of canvassers, or at the R.I. Department of Motor Vehicles, if you have any transactions there. Registration forms are available online – in English and Spanish - at the [R.I. Secretary of State's office](#). Remember, to register to vote in Rhode Island, you must do so by March 27 and be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of the Rhode Island city or town where you wish to vote
- At least 16 years of age (you must be at least 18 years of age to vote)
- You must not be currently deemed non-compos mentis by a court of law
- You must not be currently incarcerated in a correctional facility under felony conviction

Applications for mail ballots are available online – also in English and Spanish - at the [R.I. Secretary of State's office](#), and must apply by April 5. For more information, visit www.sos.ri.gov/divisions/elections.
