**DEMOCRATIC CHAIR ANNOUNCES STATE OF THE UNION (SOTU) WATCH PARTY**  
*Party Caucuses host Viewing of Obama's Final Presidential Address Tuesday, January 12,*  
*at 8 p.m. at Providence's Mirabar*

**WARWICK, R.I.** – Chair Joseph M. McNamara of the R.I. Democratic Party announced today there will be a State of the Union (#SOTU) watch party Tuesday evening at 8 p.m. at Mirabar, 15 Elbow Street, in Providence. The address – the last given by President Barack Obama – will be broadcast at 9 p.m.

In his address, Democratic National Committee officials indicate the President is expected to say the State of the Union is strong and secure; jobs have been added at a record pace, and Americans are better off than before he took office. He will also remind us that our best days are still ahead, if we elect a Democrat as the 45<sup>th</sup> President.
